REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Previous years members may pre-register by completing the enclosed registration form and mailing it back to the Club at the address shown on the front cover or return it to the club office during office hours. A separate registration must be submitted for each skater. Registration will be accepted **ONLY** when completed in full and including all the following:

1. Level of competence 2. Skate Canada Number 3. Payment using options below 4. Program Assistant form
Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Prior to August 31st, 2011, receipt of applications will be accepted based on the following criteria with HOME CLUB status taking precedence for memberships:

1. Township of Milton Resident - Home Club MSC Member.
2. Township of Milton Resident - Skater Siblings Home Club MSC Member.
3. Township of Milton Resident - New Home Club MSC Member.
4. Non-Township of Milton Resident - Home Club MSC Member.

"Township of Milton" refers to the area enclosed within the boundaries as set out by the Town of Milton Planning Department

Milton Skating Club HOME CLUB Membership Fee:

- A separate cheque for the Club/Skate Canada Membership Fee of \$175.00 must be paid by August 31, 2011 for Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Competitive Skaters after which time membership is open to all skaters including non-home club members.
- Home Club members must purchase two full regular sessions each season with the exception of skaters 14 years of age or older, and qualify for the Sr session, have the option of purchasing one session per season. Skaters eligible to skate one day a week are subject to the same rules and regulations of other skaters, and do so accepting a lower priority of ice availability than skaters who skate more than one day a week.
- There is a 5% discount if full payment by cash or cheque is received by August 31, 2011 (excluding membership fee).

Non Home Club Members:

- All Non Home Club Members are subject to a \$145.00 membership fee.
- Non Home club members are eligible for the 5% discount if full payment by cash or cheque is received by August 31, 2011.
- Must attend PA training session. If the training session conflicts with obligations of their home club, exemption from attendance must be approved by MSC canskate administrator.
- Not eligible to test without permission from home club/home club test chair as per Skate Canada out of club testing policy.
- Required to pay mandatory fundraising fee
- Select 1 (one) Program Assist subsidy package and/or pay recreational re-imbusement subsidy.

Associate Members:

- Must pay \$32.00 Skate Canada Membership Fee
- Receive NO membership privileges.

Payment Options

- Option 1:** One cheque for Membership Fee dated August 31, 2011 & 7 equal payments for session fees.

- Option 2:** One Visa/Mastercard payment for Membership Fee & Full Registration Fee processed Aug. 31, 2011.
(NO DISCOUNT APPLIES)
- Option 3:** One cheque for the Membership Fee & full Registration Fee dated August 31, 2011
(5% discount applies on registration fee only). It does not apply to membership fee, Jr Jump class, Flexibility class.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Note 1:** 3rd child in the same family may register at 1/2 price of least expensive membership (excluding Membership Fee).
- Note 2:** All NSF cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 administration fee.
- Note 3:** Refunds, if approved will be in the form of a non-transferable credit for future skating programs minus the Membership Fee of \$175.00 for all regular programs.
- Note 4:** MSC reserves the right to change/cancel programs/portions thereof if membership so warrants after registration.
- Note 5:** There will be a \$25.00 administrative fee for changes to your original registration after September 30, 2011.

Specialty Programs: Any skater that chooses to add a specialty program at any time throughout the season will be required to pay the full fee for the session. NO pro-rated fee will be applied to Specialty programs.

Guest Skating: A skater may "Guest skate" on any session for which they qualify subject to prior approval by the Figure Sating Registrar at a cost of \$10.00 (Non-Club skaters \$15.00). Fees must be delivered to the session convener or skater's coach prior to skating. This privilege is limited to 5 times per season. Guest Skating is NOT PERMITTED on Competitive or STARSKATE sessions.

Qualifications: Skaters must purchase the membership session that meets their qualifications as of July 1/11. NO mixed sessions will be permitted (ie/ skating one day of intermediate and one day of Junior). Skaters that qualify for a new session after July 1st are welcome to change their session but it is not mandatory provided space is available at the discretion of the board of directors.

Junior Members



QUALIFICATIONS: ("PASSED" refers to tests passed as of July 1, 2011)

Any skater that has completed Canskate stage 6 or is recommended by a MSC Professional coach.

Each Junior Member must purchase a minimum of two of the following full regular sessions:

Monday 5:10-6:10 p.m.

Wednesday 6:30-7:30pm

Thursday 6:25-7:25 p.m.

SPECIALTY PROGRAMS: (Purchased separately from the membership fees)

Off Ice Jump Class: Wednesday 5:15-6:15pm

Off ice Jump Classes are open to all Junior Skaters. The classes are run by a professional coach and focus on the following components; Warm up and Stretching techniques, Proper jump technique, Position strengthening, and flexibility training. Skaters are expected to wear regular skating attire with athletic running shoes. Classes are open to all Jr skaters regardless of skating day chosen.

Junior Ballet Class: Monday 6:20-7:00pm

Ballet teaches fundamental movement and body awareness that is essential for successful figure skaters. The class will be structured with figure skating in mind and will focus on performance, posture and poise.

PROGRAM ASSISTANTS:

During the first two-week orientation period of the program, the club will provide program assistants for all new Junior skaters free of charge. These program assistants are present to aid new juniors in learning how to work on their own in their new environment. They will help the skaters with their skills and encourage them to practice while not in a lesson with their professional coach.

PROFESSIONAL COACHES:

Every MSC skater must retain a professional coach. Coaching fees are in addition to the club fees listed below and are billed by the coaches and paid by the parents independent of the club. As many coaches have limited availability it is recommended to make this selection prior to the start of the season however, after the two-week orientation period all skaters must have chosen a coach. A list of our coaching staff including credentials, experience, e-mail addresses/phone numbers is available on the coaching page of this package, on our website and in our club office.

ORIENTATION BOOKLET AND MEETING:

A Junior orientation booklet has been included in all registration packages for new juniors and is also available on our website. The MSC hosts a Junior Orientation meeting and pizza party for all juniors and their parents on MONDAY OCTOBER 3rd from 6:30-7:30pm. This event gives parents a chance to meet the club president, session conveners & other parents.
