PROGRAM ASSISTANTS

All Milton Home Club Members, 11 years of age and STAR 2 LEVEL as of December 31st/19 are required to become a Program Assistant for Pre-Canskate and Canskate.

The Program Assistants Bursary

PA's receive a bursary after a one-time commitment of 20 volunteer hours. Your bursary is put on your account in a gift certificate and may only be used for club's fees such as test and registrations fees and Milton Skating Club merchandise.

As of PreCan Assistant you will receive \$5.00 and Canskate \$6.00 towards your bursary.

High School Volunteer Hours

You may choose to use your hours to complete the required "High School Volunteer Hours" instead of receiving the program assistant bursary. The club will give you a letter at the end of the year indicating the number of hours that you have volunteered for the MSC as a program assistant. If choosing this option please advise the office and Danielle Rutledge at the beginning of the season.

Program Assistants Fleece Jackets

Each new PA will receive a new, fleece jacket that will be yours to keep. You are expected to wear it each time you help with a PreCan or Canskate program.

And Finally, Subsidize Your Skating Fees

A large portion of the fees that are brought in from Canskate go directly to cover the ice costs of your sessions! Without these Canskate programs your ice fees would be considerably higher and would be limit the amount of skating time available to you.
