The Milton Skating Club's goal is to provide quality skating programming to Milton and area residents.

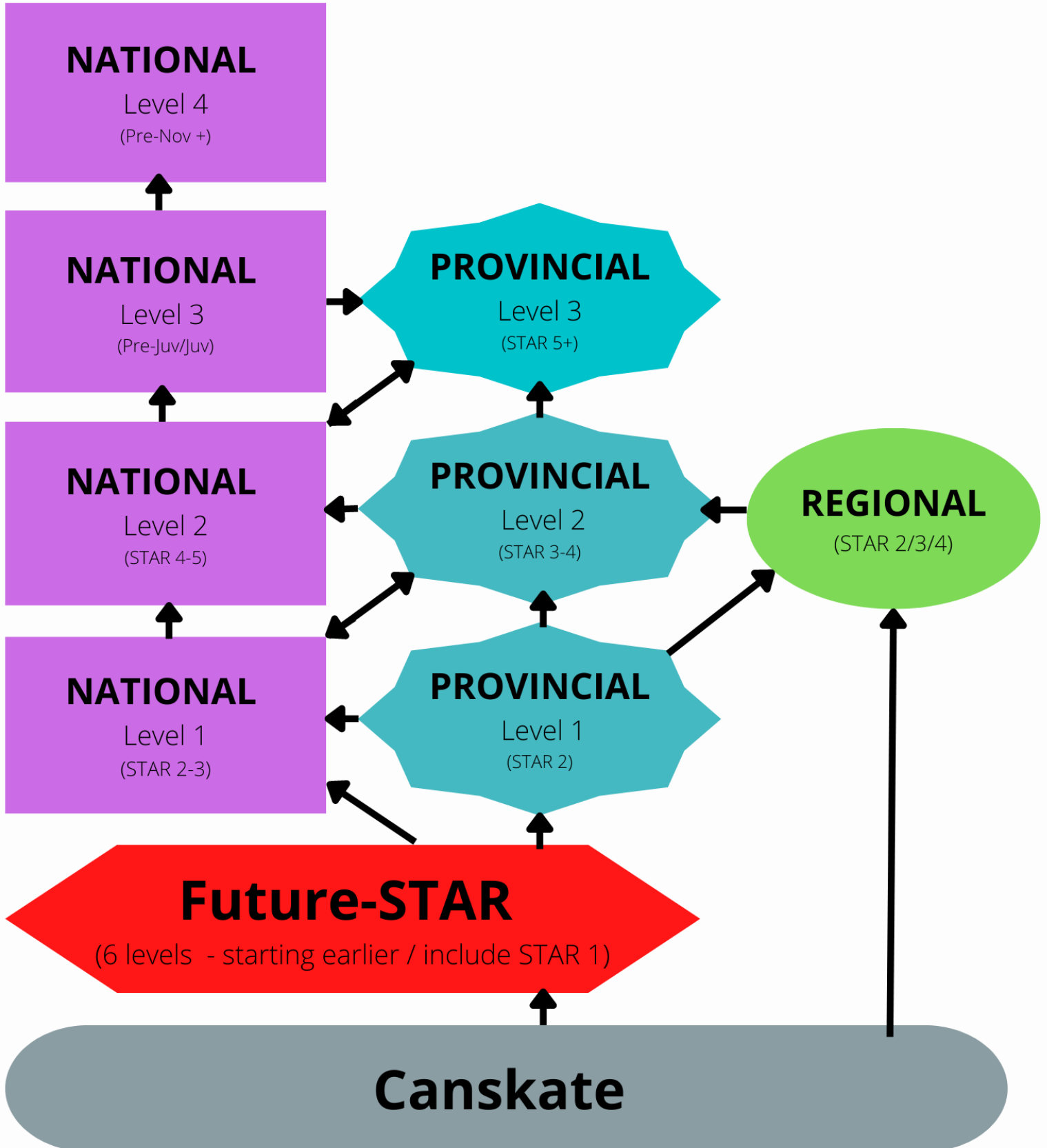

Milton Skating Club Membership Fee: The club membership fee includes the MSC administration fees, Skate Canada Membership and insurance, 2 books of Skate Ontario Lottery Tickets, Year end Award Subsidy, Testing Administration (**this portion of membership fee is NON Refundable**) and ONE 45 min off-Ice class per week (subject to refund policy and will be prorated).

Guest Skating: A skater may "Guest skate" on any session for which they qualify subject to prior approval by the TECHNICAL DIRECTOR at a cost of \$10 (Non-Club \$20). This privilege is limited to 5x / skater/ season.

Qualifications: Skaters must purchase the membership session that meets their competition level as of July 1/22. Skaters that qualify for a new session after July 1st are welcome to change session (after approval from the technical director) but movement it is not mandatory and is determined by space availability.

Specialty Programs: Any skater that chooses to add a specialty program (Ballet or Fitness) at any time throughout the season will be required to pay the full fee for the session. NO pro-rated fee will be applied to OFF-ICE programs. No 3rd child discount applies.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Members register online from the Milton Skating Club website. Registration will be accepted **ONLY** when completed in full. Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Prior to Sep 6, 2022, receipt of applications will be accepted based on the following criteria with HOME CLUB status taking precedence for memberships

1. Township of Milton Resident - Home Club MSC Member.
2. Township of Milton Resident - Skater Sibling's Home Club MSC Member.
3. Township of Milton Resident - New Home Club MSC Member.
4. Non-Township of Milton Resident - Home Club MSC Member.

"Township of Milton" refers to the area enclosed within boundaries set by Town of Milton Planning Dept.

Milton Skating Club HOME CLUB Membership Fee:

- The Milton Skating Club Membership fee must be paid by Sep 6, 2022 after which membership is open to new skaters including non-home club members. The club membership fee includes the MSC administration fees, Skate Canada Membership and insurance, 2 books of Skate Ontario Lottery Tickets, Year end Award Subsidy, Special Events Subsidy (**this portion of membership fee is NON Refundable**) and ONE 45 min off-ice class per week (subject to refund policy and will be prorated).
- Home Club members must purchase two full regular sessions each season. Skaters 14 years of age or older, who qualify for PROVINCIAL 3, have the option of purchasing one session per season. Skaters eligible to skate one day a week are subject to the same rules and regulations of all skaters, and do so accepting a lower priority of ice availability than skaters who skate more than 1 day a week.
- There is a 5% discount for full cheque/debit payment received by Sep 6/22 (excluding member fee).

Non Home Club Members:

- All Non Home Club Members are subject to the MSC membership fee. If payment is made online, the \$44 Skate Canada membership portion will be refunded.
- Non Home club members are eligible for 5% discount on session fees only if full payment by cheque or debit is received by Sep 6/22
- Must attend PA training session. If the training session conflicts with obligations of their home club, exemption from attendance must be approved by MSC Board of Directors.
- Not eligible to test without home club permission.
- Required to pay mandatory fundraising fee.
- Submit completed PA form as required or pay recreational reimbursement subsidy

Associate Members:

- Must pay \$44.00 Skate Canada Membership Fee
- Receive NO membership privileges.

Payment Options

Option 1: One time cheque/debit for the Membership Fee & full session fee dated September 6, 2022 (5% discount on session fee only). Membership fee/specialty program not applicable for discount.

Option 2: One time Visa/MC payment for Membership Fee & Full session fee processed Sep 6/22
(NO DISCOUNT APPLIES)

Option 3: One cheque/debit for Membership Fee (Sep 6/22) & 5 equal payments by VISA/MC for session fees.
Dates: Oct 1/22, Nov 1/22, Dec 1/22, Jan 1/23, and Feb 1/23.

PLEASE NOTE:

Note 1: 3rd child (sibling) 1/2 price of least expensive membership (excludes Member Fee/specialty program)

Note 2: All NSF cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 administration fee.

Note 3: Option 3 is not a monthly payment plan. If a skater chooses to leave the club once the season has started, the club refund policy applies. Unless a refund has been approved by the MSC board, full payment is owed to the club and the 5 payments will be processed on the stated dates.

Note 4: Requests for refunds/credits must be submitted in writing for review by the Club Board of Directors

Note 5: MSC reserves right to change/cancel any program if membership warrants after registration.

The Program Assistants Bursary

PA's receive a bursary after a one-time commitment of 20 volunteer hours. Your bursary is put on your account in a gift certificate and may only be used for club's fees such as test and registration fees and Milton Skating Club merchandise. As a Pre-Canskate Assistant, you will receive \$5.00 and Canskate \$6.00 towards your bursary.

High School Volunteer Hours

You may choose to use your hours to complete the required "High School Volunteer Hours" instead of receiving the program assistant bursary. The club will give you a letter at the end of the year indicating the number of hours that you have volunteered for the MSC as a program assistant. Subsidize Your Skating Fees

A large portion of the income from Canskate goes directly to cover the ice costs of figure skating sessions. Without Canskate programs ice fees would be considerably higher and would limit the amount of skating time available.

Milton Skating Club - Skater Code of Conduct

Milton Skating Club aims to promote a safe, supportive environment for the skating community that equally respects our common interests and our differences for all skaters to enjoy the sport and fulfill their own individual goals within a team spirit. In support of this objective, the Milton Skating Club has adopted the following Code of Conduct based on the following principles:

- Milton Skating Club Policies, By-laws and Rules.
- A Harassment-Free policy.

Members and parents of Future Stars to Elite are required to review, discuss and accept this Code of Conduct and indicate that they have read and understand their responsibilities by signing the attached agreement before participating in club activities.

All Milton Skating Club members must conduct themselves in a manner respectful of all policies/property at the ice rink as well as any other facility. Any violation of facility policy may result in disciplinary action from the Club. This Code of Conduct is also in effect when the Club is represented at out of rink activities. Please exhibit a model of behaviour that will provide a good example to the community and encourage pride in our Club.

- Members are expected to follow the direction of Ice Rink staff and Milton Skating Club members acting as rink attendants during Club sessions or Club events.
- Members shall not harass or abuse physically/verbally, any other skaters/coaches/officials/parent at any time.
- At team events, simulations and competitions, skaters are encouraged to make an effort to support their fellow skaters during their performances.
- Members are expected to follow any coach's instructions where that coach may request restrictions on routines or elements that he/she deems unsafe or dangerous to other skaters on any club ice session.
- Members are expected to follow the Ice Etiquette and Guidelines for fun and safe skating shown below.
- Any act performed by a Club member that a rink attendant, member, coach or parent sees and deems inappropriate or unsafe may be brought to the Milton Skating Club Board's attention for disciplinary action.

Conflict Resolution

With many different people and personalities coming together to participate in skating - whether as skaters, friends, family, fans, coaches or staff - it is no surprise that conflicts will occasionally arise from differences of opinion or simple misunderstandings.

If a member wishes to object to an instruction by Ice Rink staff, coach, parent or fellow skater, the member shall make the objection known to his/her own convener first. The skater's convener is responsible for the resolution of the issue. If the coach cannot reach resolution of the issue, the coach shall then bring the matter to the Board of Directors in writing.

Flex Roles and Table Duty shifts are FIRST come, FIRST serve basis. Skaters 18 years of age and older may fulfill select volunteer (flex) commitments; excluding CanSkate Table duty.

Goals of the Program:

- Share the work fairly among the membership
- Ensure that our club runs efficiently
- Reward those that volunteer beyond their commitment

Table Duty - Shift Requirements:

1. During your shift, you will staff the Canskate table, hand out colour tags to skaters, answer questions parents may have, direct families to change rooms, hand out report cards (if applicable) and advise them of permitted spectator location as per Town/Club protocols.
2. Must stay for your full shift unless advised otherwise by a Convenor/Coach and remain at the table so you are visible and accessible to Parent/Guardians. Be sure to dress with comfort and warmth in mind as you will be standing and inside a cold rink.
3. Be sure to sign-in every shift in the binder provided for attendance to record your volunteer hours.

Table Duty - Unfulfilled Commitment:

Families that do NOT fulfill their time commitment will be billed **\$50.00** for each 4-HOUR shift that is missed. Members however may SWITCH shifts with other members in advance of the shift if a member is unable to meet the commitment. The Office will provide a volunteer contact list for YOU to find/secure a replacement.

Buy Out Option

You may choose to Buy-Out of the Canskate Table/Flex Hours. Fees for the Buy-Out Option are as follows:

It will also be posted to our Club bulletin board inside RINK A. A contact list will be made available to volunteer parents in the event of a shift replacement. It is the parents' responsibility to find and secure a shift replacement independent of the club and must also inform the office as soon as a shift is switched for our records.

If you are required to do more than one shift, it will be assigned on rotation throughout the current skating season and not back to back months - Season schedule begins September 2022 through to June 2023.
